The essays will be judged on their originality, development of theme, content, punctuation, spelling, and grammar. The winners will be announced at the SHS Honors & Awards Night tentatively scheduled for April 18, 2017.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All entries must be:

- The original work of the submitter
- No less than 800 and no more than 1400 words
- Submitted in Times New Roman (12-font), double-spaced with 1-inch margins
- Two copies submitted for judging
- Submitted in a sealed 8½x11 envelope addressed to the 2017 PTSA Community Service Scholarship
- Submitted with a copy of this application form by **Friday, March 3, 2017** to the SHS Front Office.
